#### **GROWING**

Please read Psalm 118, verses 19-24 with me responsively

- <sup>19</sup> Open to me the gates of righteousness, **that I may enter through them and give thanks to the Lord.**
- <sup>20</sup> This is the gate of the Lord; **the righteous shall enter through it**.
- <sup>21</sup> I thank you that you have answered me **and have become my salvation.**
- <sup>22</sup> The stone that the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone.
- <sup>23</sup> This is the Lord's doing; **it is marvelous in our eyes.**
- <sup>24</sup> This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

- \* How many times have we found ourselves walking a path in life with a heavy heart? The hearts of the women taking this early morning walk must have been heavy and broken. But this morning was like no other, and it changed the lives of untold billions of people since that day. Hear now the HOLY EASTER GOSPEL according to Matthew the 28<sup>th</sup> chapter **Glory to you, O Lord**

NARRATOR: After the sabbath, as the first day of the week was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb. And suddenly there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord, descending from heaven, came and rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as snow. For fear of him the guards shook and became like dead men. But the angel said to the women,

ANGEL: "Do not be afraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples, 'He has been raised from the dead, and indeed he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him.' This is my message for you."
